upcoming Service Symposium. Also that we will be seeking a new FD Leader and Co Leader due to the fact that
Scott will be resigning from his position and will not acclimate to the FD Leader.

Treasurer Report

Hello everyone.

As I stated during the RSC, In November I discovered that the RSO failed to transfer \$1,415.46. The RSO did a through investigation of deposits and found that an additional \$3,537.92 was not sent to the RSC. On 1/6/2021, the RSO transferred \$4,953.38. I was also told that new policies have been put into place to prevent this from happening in the future. However, please check the reports to ensure your area/group/member funds have been received.

During the admin meeting we discussed the statewide helpline. I discovered that we have not sent a payment to the SFRSC since Jan 2020. I was provided a login to obtain the invoices and mailed a check for \$2,675.79 which is FRSC's half for the entire year of 2020. I have set up a reminder in QuickBooks so that this is not missed again as well as other regular recurring payments.

On November 1, 2020 the opening Bank of America balance was \$16,705.40 + Deposits \$2,240.00 – Expenses \$345.00 = \$18,600.41. After deducting Prudent Reserve \$11,000.00, Women in Service Donation \$75.00, & Service Symposium Expenses \$1,139.40 leaves \$6,386.01 available for use. In January, another \$5,953.93 was added to the available balance for a total of \$12,339.94 (See Below). The FRSC have decided to forego sending World any funds over prudent reserves until the audit is performed and are certain that all payments have been made.

Technology Resource Coordinator Report

FSS Tech Workshops - We are seeking clarity regarding who's responsible for coming up with and arranging the tech workshops. We've gotten a few different directions depending on who we speak with. We understand that there is a meeting on Friday to get a lot of the planning underway but are asking if we could get clarification on just this one aspect today as we're already pretty far behind and would rather not wait until Friday to get started on asking people to participate.

YAP - YAP is the new statewide helpline system that we're setting up for the entire region that will also be available to each area to utilize with their current helpline number. It is a system that was created for Narcotics Anonymous by fellow addicts. Therefore, it's custom tailored to fix our needs and comes with many options that include (but aren't limited to) multilingual, texting etc

The backbone for Yap is now up and live. Please fill out this form https://forms.gle/T321RajwD8JtWtKH7 so IT has a point of contact for your helpline committee/chair so we can coordinate with them like we did with the BMLT

migration. I just need to confirm with South Florida that the routing of the statewide number to their areas is set up. Then we can start porting numbers. The twilio account (phone carrier) is being set up under the RSO's 501c3 status which will save us 25% on the bill and give us \$500 in starting credit which should last a few months. Projected costs are roughly \$100/month for the entire state, split 50-50 with South Florida as the current system is supposed to be, but that's a very rough estimate and dependent on how many minutes we use, therefore subject to vary monthly. We will be keeping the same number we have for the statewide number. Areas will be able to port over their helpline numbers and there will not be any cost (monthly or one-time) to the Areas that are currently on Grasshopper who join. Areas on OneBox or other services may have small port-out fees (doesn't seem to be more than \$35), or may need to purchase their numbers if they don't own it and want to keep that number. Grasshopper is going away, and we will work with the 3 areas on OneBox or other services to move you over.

Sub - This is an SMS-based (texting) alerting system that will allow for announcements from Admin/FD to the RSC body only at this point. It's written by the developers of the BMLT, however it hasnt received much love and care in a long time. I have found a couple bugs, as well as lot of room for improvement. As a member of the BMLT community, I am going to be getting involved in committing code for this project and making it fit not just our needs, but anyone who wishes to use it.

Since we're not meeting in person we decided to not renew the mobile hotspots as it saves us \$40 a month. The RSO chose not to renew theirs either. They will need to be reactivated one month prior to needing them.

The website workgroup is going well. The wireframe for the site has been created so it was really cool to get a feel for how the site is going to look. We have accounted for the costs related to the new site in our yearly budget.

Corrections Resource Coordinator Report

Greetings Florida Region,

My name is Colin H and I'm an addict. I am currently serving as the Corrections Coordinator for the Florida Region.

Corrections is still struggling. Many of our volunteers have young children or older parents anddo not wish to continue to take meetings in during these times.

What we need on the workgroup:

Volunteers willing to take meetings into facilities who are comfortable with masks and personal health preparations enough to still bring meetings in.

A secretary to coordinate communication with the facilities and the volunteers and to maintain the Google drive and the calendar for when we go into facilities, and to chaperone the WG meetings. This would be a couple hours of work per week.

A webservant to maintain the https://behindthewalls.us/ website and talk with the secretary to keep the list of institutions we are serving up to date. Again, a couple hours of work per week.

A Volunteer coordinator: This person would communicate and coordinate with the Inmate Step working group (ISWG) out of Gold Coast, the area H&I chairs to see if they have volunteers willing to take meetings into DOC or Federal institutions in their areas and to maintain and connect with the volunteers we have in the database now to encourage them to attend meetings and track and ensure that they have maintained the state requirements for training. Again, a couple hours a week.

A PR person to do presentations at institutions and share what we offer (institution meetings, step writing penpals via ISWG, Bridging the Gap (meet up at a meeting once released), by mailing flyers to institutions and ensuring that they know about us. This would include some travel (which would be reimbursed at the IRS nonprofit level), so you'd need to have a car, a valid DL and insurance. This would require maybe an hour a week of answering emails and such plus 1 day every few months to travel and do presentations.

FIPT Project

The progress made on the Fellowship Intellectual Property Trust Project has been posted the review as an and input draft of proposed changes for a six-month Fellowship review at: www.na.org/fipt. The review period is from December 1, 2020 through May 31, 2021.

COURT CASE

To refresh your memory, in early 2020, a group of members calling themselves "the Autonomous Region" petitioned the court to remove NA World Services as Trustee of the Fellowship Intellectual Property Trust. The judge issued a final decision at the end of September, and we were looking forward to putting the matter behind us. Regrettably, the group of members who initially brought the case have now filed an appeal, so we will have to spend more money and energy that could be going to supporting efforts to carry the message to the addict who still suffers. TRANSLATIONS

We have published 80 new translated pieces since March—the equivalent of 1 every three days. SPAD

The fourth batch of entries has been posted for Fellowship review through the end of January. There are 75 entries on ten spiritual principles: anonymity, discernment, empathy, faith, gratitude, honesty, hope, open-mindedness, vigilance, and willingness. They welcome your input on as many or few entries as you like. There are also spiritual principles posted for you to write about. NA literature is written by addicts, for addicts—addicts like you! WCNA

We are certain that the World Convention will not happen in 2021, and they are investigating moving the date for the World Convention to the following year, 2022.

HRP Report

Good Afternoon Florida Region:

HRP had three zoom meetings since the November 2020 RSC. There were two meetings in December and one meeting during the RSC January 2021 weekend.

During the December 12, 2020 meeting, we discussed the procedural errors that occurred during the RSC Elections for the RSO Treasurer. During the nomination process, the HRP Lead neglected to follow the procedure for waiving the Regional Service experience as identified on page 15 in the Guide to Regional Services. Language has been added to our best practice to ensure this error does not re-occur. Also discussed was the communication failure that overlooked the acclimation of the alternative treasurer to treasurer.

Attendance/participation at RSC and HRP meeting was addressed.

As of December 2020, only 7 new volunteer forms have been received. Strategies discussed to increase the number of volunteer forms received include, posting the link for the volunteer form in the chat during RSC weekends and posting the link during the Service Symposium.

We also discussed how the zoom platform has impacted the election process. During the last election, HRP was omitted from the election process. HRP and IT worked together to establish the following:

- 1. Results go to HRP (HRP Lead and HRP Guide)
- 2. Add abstain as an option (Yes, No, or Abstain)
- 3. Ensure we can identify the area
- 4. Help identify if devices have the latest version of zoom (Allows access to participate in the polls).

In an effort to help the new RCM obtain a better understanding of HRP, we requested 30-40 minutes during January 2021 Fellowship Development to introduce the members of HRP and discuss our roles.

The set schedule for the first check-in of elected trust servants. The FD Leader requested to be included. The goal of the check-in is to determine the following:

- 1. Adjustment to the zoom platform?
- 2. Self-Evaluation of their performance.
- 3. Identify if any assistance is required.
- 4. Provide feedback based on our observation
- 5. Discussion replacement for those coordinators acclimating.

We reviewed the following sections of the Best Practice:

- Interview questions
- Election process (Zoom and Face to Face)
- Attendance/Participation

Discussed the following RCM suggestions

- Mock Interview
- Exit Interview

HRP voted against holding mock interview but voted to start conducting exit interviewing which started last month.

Completed the Fellowship Development Project Suggestion form to create a Financial workgroup consisting of current and past treasurers to assist with training, best practices, and auditing.

HRP Guide reviewed the results of her audit of the Guide. All new changes to the Guide will be seen in the 2021 Guide. Currently the changes to the guide are tracked in red until July 2021, at which time the Final Guide will be presented. The audit identified instances where changes should have been made as indicated by the proposals but were not. Also discovered were changes made without the RSC knowledge. HRP will submit proposals to reverse any changes made without consensus as well as those changes missed. All proposals submitted by HRP will contain language clearly identifying the reason for the change, the date of the original proposal, the maker, and the outcome from the body.

On December 19, 2021 HRP and FD Leader had a zoom meeting with the IT&S co-coordinator, former H&I coordinator, and FD co-facilitator to conduct the first monthly check-in.

The meeting with the IT&S Co-Coordinator went well. She reported everything was going well and expressed excitement when discussing the current and future projects.

The H&I Coordinator declined to run for another term, but has agreed to fill in until some one is elected to the position. He stated there was not a lot of work since most facilities were not allowing outside meetings. He also reported a lack of support from areas as a point of frustration for him.

The FD Co-leader indicated that due to personal reasons, he would be stepping down as FD Co-leader.

During the January 16, 2021 HRP Zooming Meeting HRP collaborated with the RSO HR to discuss the following:

- Waiving Regional experience
- Re-election process for Steve B. and Chris A.
- RSO Board Member Candidate Waylon M.

We interviewed RSC elected RSO Board Member Candidate Waylon M. Additionally, we discussed the new election format and procedures.

HRP voted against submitting another proposal to leave the fifth position vacant.

In order to maintain accurate information, HRP will send an email to any member of the Human Resource Pool whose information is two years old requesting they renew their service interest and update their information. Any Human Resource pool member who does not respond to the renewal request within 60 days will be deemed inactive.

Hello everyone.

As I stated during the RSC, In November I discovered that the RSO failed to transfer \$1,415.46. The RSO did a through investigation of deposits and found that an additional \$3,537.92 was not sent to the RSC. On 1/6/2021, the RSO transferred \$4,953.38. I was also told that new policies have been put into place to prevent this from happening in the future. However, please check the reports to ensure your area/group/member funds have been received.

During the admin meeting we discussed the statewide helpline. I discovered that we have not sent a payment to the SFRSC since Jan 2020. I was provided a login to obtain the invoices and mailed a check for \$2,675.79 which is FRSC's half for the entire year of 2020. I have set up a reminder in QuickBooks so that this is not missed again as well as other regular recurring payments.

On November 1, 2020 the opening Bank of America balance was \$16,705.40 + Deposits \$2,240.00 - Expenses \$345.00 = \$18,600.41. After deducting Prudent Reserve \$11,000.00, Women in Service Donation \$75.00, & Service Symposium Expenses \$1,139.40 leaves \$6,386.01 available for use. In January, another \$5,953.93 was added to the available balance for a total of \$12,339.94 (See Below). The FRSC have decided to forego sending World any funds over prudent reserves until the audit is performed and are certain that all payments have been made.
